- All Champion Power Equipment products equipped with gasoline powered engines.
- 1) Make sure your engine is turned OFF, and has cooled sufficiently to allow handling.
- 2) Locate the engraved serial number on the side of the crank case.



3) The Date of Manufacture (DOM) indicator may be found within the engines serial number. Locate first four digits (all numbers) of serial number.



- 4) You may decipher the engine DOM as followers:
  - First two digits = Year
  - Second two digits = Month

Example: 1008 = August 2010
